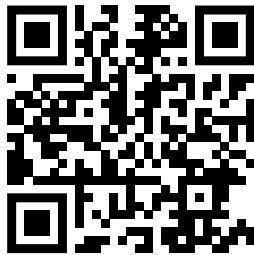
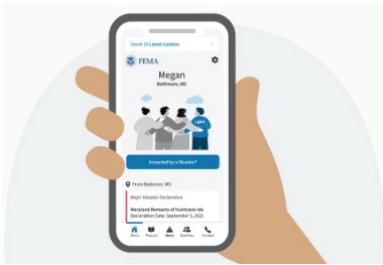
### September is National Preparedness Month

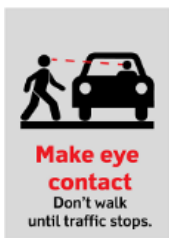


## WALK THIS WAY

**Pedestrian Safety Tips**



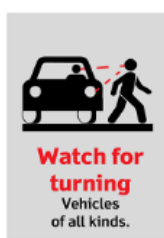
**Unplug**

Vehicles of all kinds.



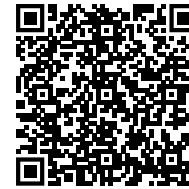
